

Campaign Guidelines

Campaign Locations Allowed

Lockers—scotch tape ONLY
Brick surfaces – Painters Tape ONLY
Cinder Block Surfaces--clear packing
tape ONLY
Doors—Painters Tape ONLY

Campaign Locations Not Allowed

Painted surfaces
Glass Surfaces including windows
NO DUCK OR MASKING TAPE

Additional Campaign Suggestions

- **NO stickers allowed**
- **NO throwing items from the stage during the skit.**
- Other appropriate trinkets allowed
- **Absolutely NO campaigning, either verbally or by way of handout, during general sessions or Miniversities**
- All posters and banners must be removed prior to leaving Saturday afternoon

Campaign Presentations

- Presidential candidates receive 4 minutes per school.
- Other candidates receive 3 minutes per school.
- After time allotted you will be asked to stop presentation.
- Presentation must be appropriate and should state why school is qualified for office.
- Although not required, we encourage you to be creative in incorporating this information into your presentation.

Voting

- Each council receives 4 votes for each office
- All ballots are to be returned for tabulation immediately following the general session.
- Election results will be announced during the last general session Saturday afternoon.
