Scholarship to Missouri Institute for Student Leadership

The MASC Northwest District will award two scholarships to the Missouri Institute for Student Leadership ("student council camp") held at William Woods University, Fulton, Missouri. The camp dates for 2009 are June 7-12.

One scholarship will be awarded to a high school student who is currently a junior, sophomore, or freshman (grades 9-11).

One scholarship will be awarded to a middle school student who is currently in the eighth, seventh, or sixth grade.

Each school may submit completed applications from three (3) students.

The completed application must be postmarked no later than **Friday, April 17, 2009**.
