## Starting from the Rolla area:

- 1) Start out going **WEST** on **W 10TH ST/MO-BB** toward **N PINE ST**.
- 2) Turn **RIGHT** onto **I-44 BL E/US-63 N/MO-72 N/N BISHOP AVE**. Continue to follow **US-63 N**.
- 3) Turn **SLIGHT RIGHT** onto **MO-28**.
- 4) Turn **RIGHT** onto **MO-C**.
- 5) Turn **LEFT** to stay on **MO-C**.
- 6) Turn **LEFT** onto **MO-B**.
- 7) Turn **SLIGHT RIGHT** onto **MO-28**.
- 8) Turn **LEFT** onto **MO-19**.
- 9) Turn **LEFT** onto **US-50/MO-19**. Continue to follow **MO-19**.
- 10) Turn **LEFT** onto **MO-100/W 14TH ST**. Continue to follow **MO-100**.
- 11) **164 E HIGHWAY 100**.

## Starting from Washington area:

- 1) Start out going **SOUTHEAST** on **W 3RD ST** toward **JEFFERSON ST**.
- 2) Turn **RIGHT** onto **JEFFERSON ST**.
- 3) Turn **RIGHT** onto **MO-100**.
- 4) Turn **LEFT** onto **MO-19 S/MARKET ST S**. Continue to follow **MO-19 S**.
- 5) Turn **RIGHT** onto **MO-100/W 14TH ST**. Continue to follow **MO-100**.
- 6) **164 E HIGHWAY 100**.

### ***With a Dose of Smile Therapy. . .***

Camp Quality is a summer camping experience and year-round support program for children with cancer. Many difficult physical and emotional challenges face a child, and his or her family, when battling cancer. At our summer camps we have developed an important type of "therapy" . . . we like to call it Smile Therapy! With a laugh in their hearts and smiles on their faces, Camp Q. Kids find themselves capable of more than they may have dreamed possible.

### ***We Laugh, Love, Lift-up . . .***

Camp Quality has built its reputation on personalized care. Every camper is paired with a companion who is dedicated completely to his or her care. Companions are the life-blood of Camp Q; they are fun to be with, adventuresome, great listeners and are always sharing their love for life. Their primary responsibility is to make sure their camper has the most enjoyable, safe, relaxing and restoring experience possible. This relationship creates a beautiful bond that continues long after camp is over, and oftentimes for years to come.

### ***Normal Kids with Extraordinary Lives . . .***

Surrounded by new friends that can relate, loving volunteers who care, and

loads of fun experiences, Camp Quality campers find joy, new courage and renewed hope for the future. They are free to be themselves . . . free to be kids again.

### *History*

The first Camp Quality was established "Down Under" in Sydney, Australia, in 1983 by Vera Entwistle. Founder Entwistle was responsible for introducing Camp Quality to several countries, including the United States.

The first USA camp was held the summer of 1986 in Northwest Missouri with 43 campers. Today, Camp Quality Northwest Missouri typically hosts 100 campers, and 14 additional camp locations offer this unique experience to hundreds more.

### *Our Name*

Camp Quality was suggested by a statement made to founder Entwistle:

*"No one can do anything about the quantity of life, but we all can do something about the quality."*

Our name is based on the experience we provide for each child - quality time with quality people who present a quality program.

### *Camp Quality in Central Missouri*

Each Camp Quality location offers a unique camping experience under the umbrella of the Camp Quality USA organization. In Central Missouri, we serve about 40 children per summer- children in all stages of their battle with cancer as well as some siblings of cancer patients. Offering the program to siblings ensures a much needed rest for parents. Most of our children are referred through the University of Missouri Children's Hospital, and our kids come from all parts of mid-Missouri; Glasgow, California, Booneville, Columbia, Jefferson City, Wellsville, Belle, Eldon, Dixon, Macon, and many of the other small towns that make our community unique.

We are funded 100% through donations from generous individuals and local service organizations. Camp Quality does not receive governmental funding, United Way money, or funding from the American Cancer Society. All of our local staff members and organizing committee members are volunteers, so your donation goes directly to sending kids to Camp. We offer ordinary camping experiences such as fishing, swimming, and horseback riding as well as extraordinary experiences like hot air balloon rides and world class entertainers. We are very aware that kids do things at Camp Quality for the first time, and they do things at Camp Quality for the last time.

### *How Can I Help?*

### ***Become a Camp Q. Companion***

A camper's "best friend for the week" is their Camp Quality Companion. The caring and supportive relationship between the pair begins at camp, and continues to be fostered throughout the year. In many cases, Camp Q. Kids develop such strong friendships with their quality companions that they ask to be matched up year after year.

Camp Q. Companions come from all walks of life-- teachers, college students, lawyers, young professionals, retired professionals, police officers, firefighters. Quality companions must be willing to invest their time, energy and heart into the experience of their camper . . . but the return is priceless.

### ***Involve Your Service Organization***

Do you know of a service organization or company that would like to become a part of the Camp Quality experience? Our camps take pride in the community support they foster, and are always looking for more friendships. Here's just a selection of how local businesses and organizations helped Camp Quality last year: the Optimists Club put on a fishing derby, Harley Bike Riders Association posed for pictures with Camp Q. kids and applied temporary tattoos, a local fire department showed off the "World's Largest Super Soaker," Home Depot provided wood kits and supplies to build a variety of crafts, Dairy Queen supplied free ice cream bars.
