



Southeast District Summer Leadership Camp Scholarship

The Southeast District will award two scholarships to MASC Summer Leadership Camp at William Woods University, Fulton, Missouri. Camp dates are June 6-11, 2010.

One scholarship will be a full registration scholarship (\$350) and one will be a scholarship in the amount of \$250 toward registration fee of \$350.

The scholarships will be awarded to a high school student who is currently a junior, sophomore or freshman (grades 9-11).

Each school may submit completed applications from three (3) students.

The completed application must be postmarked no later than **Friday, March 12, 2010.**
