We are looking for past Student Council leaders who have demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities and continued their excellence beyond high school.

These individuals will directly work with current office staff to manage the daily operations of all activities of Summer Workshop on the campus of William Woods University. This role is unlike any other as a Junior Counselor or delegate and requires one to be able to acknowledge the difference in your past and current position on staff. Similar to the JC role, this position is unpaid however all expenses for the week are covered by MASC. Eligibility:

- Must have attended MASC Summer Workshop and served at least one year as a Junior Counselor.
- Must currently be enrolled at a higher education institution or have graduated from high school no more than five years ago.
- Individual need not currently reside in Missouri or be attending a Missouri college or university.
- Previous Interns must reapply each year and will be considered among all applicants.
- Intern must be able to fully commit to the days of June 5-11, 2010. If at the time of the application deadline you are unsure of your availability (work, other internship, etc.) please apply but make note of your circumstance in part III of the application. As soon as you are aware of your summer plans, immediately inform us.

Requirements:

1. Fill out the enclosed application. Please be honest in your application. We are always looking for ways to improve Summer Workshop and your honesty on what can be improved is encouraged.
2. Ensure your email and phone is current and correct. If your information will change between the time you apply and June, make note of that on the application.
3. Include a current resume with emphasis on post high school activities and leadership roles.
4. Include a current photograph of yourself.
5. Feel free to include additional materials, ideas, or anything that will highlight what you can bring to Summer Workshop. (Example: T-shirt designs, general session presentations)
6. Please note any contingencies of accepting the position and update us if anything changes after you apply. We understand people must also consider summer employment, career internships, summer classes, etc.
7. Postmark deadline is March 1, 2010. Ensure your application is postmarked by the deadline. Late applications will not be accepted. All applicants will be notified around April 1, 2010.
