

# Windows Live MovieMaker

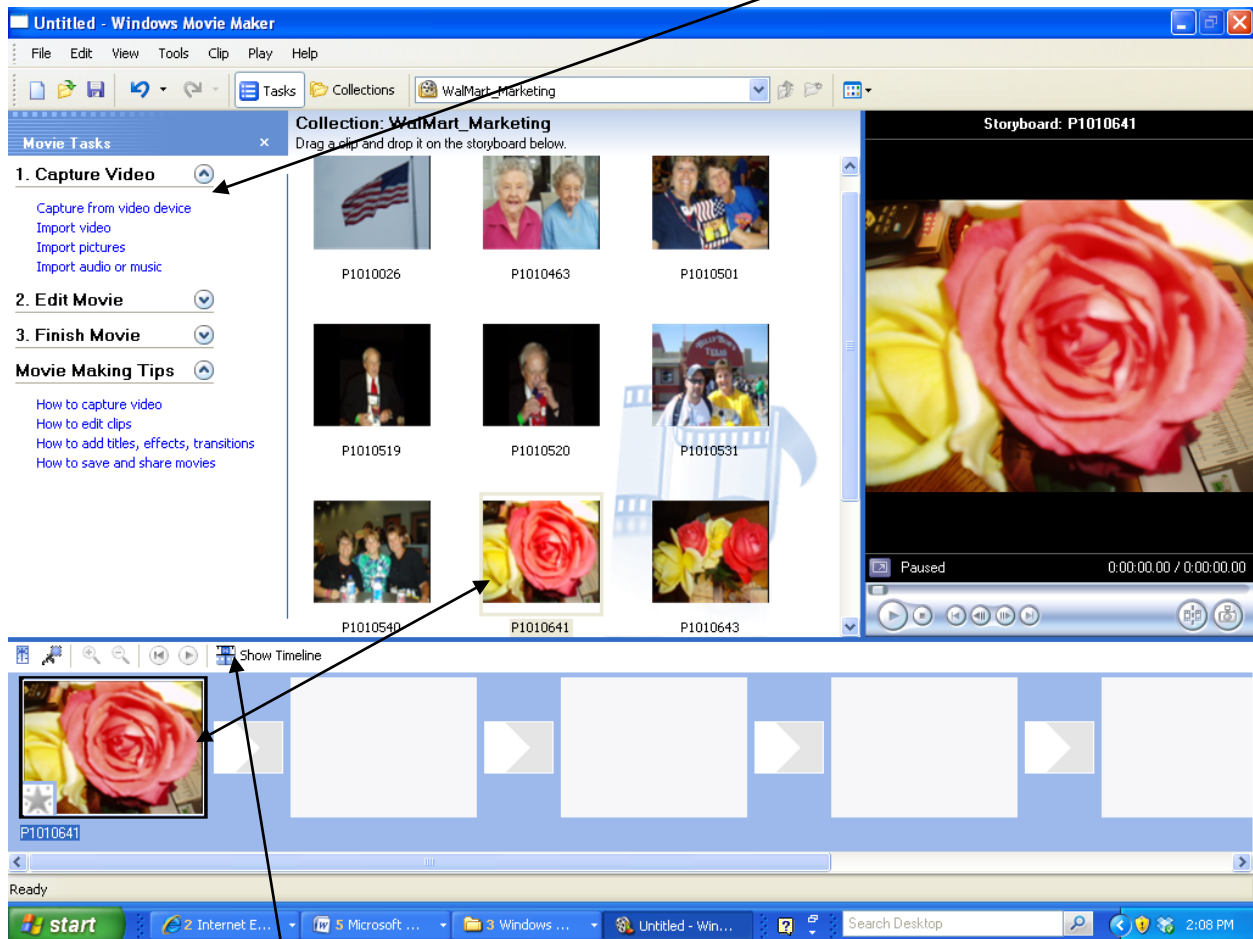
## Windows Movie Maker—Free on Windows Based Computers

**Note:** These instructions are for Movie Maker in Windows XP. Movie Maker in Windows Vista has a different look and interface and directions will vary. “Windows Live Movie Maker” takes the place of Movie Maker in Windows 7. Go to <http://windowslive.com/desktop/moviemaker> to download “Windows Live Movie Maker” for Windows 7.

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1. Start/Programs/Windows Movie Maker or SEARCH for Windows Movie Maker
2. On left--Select CAPTURE VIDEO and which source your video or pictures are located
3. Import the video or pictures into the collections area.
4. Drag and place pictures or video on the timeline



5. Select timeline --to change the timeline view

6. Import Music or audio to place on the timeline the same way you added video
7. Add transitions & video effects under EDIT MOVIE
8. Select Finish Movie, SAVE and render to create final project to desired location
