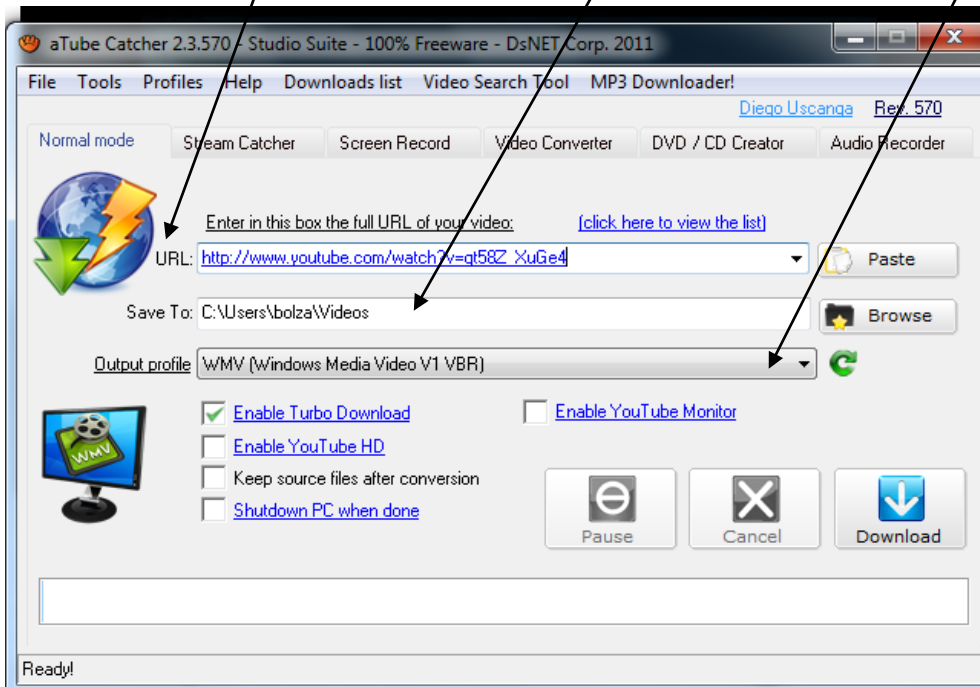


1. Download Atube Catcher program
<http://atube-catcher.en.softonic.com/>
2. Locate a YouTube video you want to use and copy the URL of the YouTube site.

2. Past the URL into atube---**Note where you save your video file.** SAVE WMV for most video
