- Making Dog toys from old t-shirts
- Hygiene packs- travel size items
- Foster kid care packs
- Art packs for CMH
- Sock Babies/bibs for preemies
- Cards for Veterans/CMH/Homeless
- School Supply Packs for kids
- "Welcome Home" kits for families transitioning to shelters/out of violence
- Tie blankets
- Homeless kits/snack bags
- New Student Package- kits for kids new to your school
- Partner with a local service agency in your area to determine a need in your own community!
- Creating a BRCX ribbon - cut out hands and writing names/messages of support- share some information/education piece as well
- Smile Bags- decorate a white canvas bag and fill with art supplies to donate to RMD House
- Tea and Cocoa packs to give to first responders. Make homemade mixes and package at convention.
- No-Sew Heart pillows to give to hospitals
- Plastic Bag sleeping Mats- weave out of old grocery sacks- give to homeless
- Cards/snack bags for bus drivers/janitors
- Cards/pictures for nursing home residents
- Painting rocks with positive images/messages- place in your community!
- Free rice.com- (requires a computer or phone)
- Chemo care kit package- candies, sanitizers, scarves, etc.
- Decorate placemats for Meals on Wheels/Nursing Home
- Snack Socks- using socks, fill with small snacks- give to homeless
- Paper flowers- give to nursing/veterans homes- don't wilt
- Portable first aid kits- give to homeless/shelters
- Make bath bombs
- Gratitude Room- Make thank you cards for people you are thankful for!
- Weighted blankets for kids (autism/sensory processing disorders)
